The proposed facility will be used for families, not individuals. Second and third floor will be for resident rooms. Main floor will be for day use such as offices, clinics, meeting/dining rooms, commercial kitchen and daycare area.

Motion to support Great Falls Rescue Mission's application for the conditional use permit moved to be accepted by Trevor, seconded by Lisa, carried unanimously.
