

## 5/13/15 7:00 PM Neighborhood Council # 2

Meeting called to order by Chair Strickland—saying the Pledge of Allegiance. Secretary Olson takes attendance; Chair Strickland, Vice-Chair Patera, Mr. McCoy, and Secretary Olson are present. A quorum is established.

### New Business:

- Albert Ferderer, 616 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave SW has expressed interest in the NHC # 2 vacancy. He has lived on the west side since 1996. Some of his concerns were boulevard trees, highway upgrade to asphalt on 6<sup>th</sup> St and handicapped access. We did not vote at this time, there was interest expressed and will be voted on at next meeting.
- Bob Moretti stood in for Officer Kimmitt who could not make it.
  - Mr. McCoy has had some concerns about crime in W. Kiwanis park due to the lack of lighting. There were 2 responses in 2013 and 9 in 2014.
  - For the first quarter:
    - 11 abandoned vehicles, 4 accident/injury, 3 assaults, 4 DUI, 3 Narcotic, 31 suspicious activity, 20 thefts, 17 vandalism, 35 wanted/ warrant arrests

### Other Business:

- Airport Sound Mapping Public Meeting- Mary Willmarth. Wednesday May 27 in the Panorama room from 5:30-7pm. There are preliminary maps at Planning and Development, City offices, Library and on the Airport website.
  - Comment period is 30 days and will end June 19<sup>th</sup>.
  - This meeting focuses on the entire study
- We will not be meeting for the summer months, however we are having a special meeting June 24<sup>th</sup> to update on Holman building after the Council of Council meeting. Motioned by Mr. McCoy, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Vice-Chair Patera, unanimous decision.
- Council of Councils: Chair Strickland will speak on Holman update- that we sent our letter out.
  - Council 7 wants to possibly get ordinances changed so mobile vendors can be down at Gibson once Park & Ponder is torn down.
  - Council 3 wants to possibly talk about traffic and resolutions after the housing boom up top

### Neighborhood Concerns:

- Marianne asked about getting a handicapped parking sign outside her home. Vice Chair Patera said to talk to planning and development. She also asked about a hot tub ordinance
- Hay Man- trying to get full yellow curbs on 6<sup>th</sup> in certain areas due to lack of visibility.

### Old Business:

- Approval of minutes for April 2015- as corrected. Motion by Mr. McCoy, Chair Strickland 2<sup>nd</sup>, unanimous.
- Holman letter was sent. If we do not hear back we will continue with Plan A.

- No West Levee Update- Ms. Mares was not present
- West Kiwanis Park Update-
  - Still waiting to hear on trees. Mr. McCoy has talked to Joe and Todd Semanski about these.
  - Lighting at W. Kiwanis would only be provided when the neighbors sign a petition and they would have to both pay for the poles and the increase in energy charges.

Mr. McCoy made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:16pm. Vice-Chair Patera 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion.
