

Neighborhood Council #4 Minutes

May 26th 2016

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm by Chairwoman Sandra Guynn and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business:

-Officer Clint Houston presented about how Neighborhood Council #4 is one of the calmest areas in town. He had a graph that showed all of the calls in the area, of which he stated more than likely most happened on Tenth Avenue South. He also spoke about the new DDACTS area and the coverage of officers in the rest of the city. He also answered questions from those in attendance.

- Great Falls Public Schools Principals Maenwaring and Ingalls presented a slide show about the GFPS Facilities Plan/Bond Issue proposal and answered questions from those in attendance. School Board Chair, Jan Cahill was also involved in answering questions about the proposed bond issue.

Committee Reports:

-Harold spoke about the last Police Advisory Board meeting. At the meeting they talked about the new DDACTS area. It was also announced that it is budget time for the Police Department and that they are going to ask the city for funds to add three more officers, one of which being a SVU Officer, which will amount to \$214,000 to come from city funds and a request of \$9,000 for miscellaneous uses.

-Sandra presented on what was covered at the Council of Councils meeting on May 24th, 2016. Items discussed were: the Park and Recreation department was there presenting about the new master plan they are working on and the next meetings for that are on June 21st and 22nd, the fireworks town hall meeting, the Holman building and that the city attorney is working on code enforcement on the building, and that Neighborhood Council 5 is going to have meeting on June 30th with representatives from Wal-Mart and Super 1 Foods there to discuss their projects.
