-Cascade City-County Health Department, Health Officer Tonya Houston presented the 2015 Annual Report from the Health Department and answered questions from those in attendance.

- GFFR Chief Hester and GFFR Captain Furr presented a slide show on the history of the Great Falls Fire Rescue department and what is currently happening with the department. They also answered questions from those in attendance.

-The Council voted to change the August meeting date to August 18th so we can hold the meeting at the Lewis & Clark Elementary School. Dan made a motion to change the meeting date and Harold Seconded the motion with it passing unanimously.

Committee Reports:

-Sandra presented notes from the Neighborhood Council #5 meeting that was held June 20th. They had speakers from the Walmart and Super 1 Foods stores to talk about the construction progress and to talk about the overall projects. Walmart is scheduled to open around March 1st, 2017 and there are lots available for four other businesses to go in. Super 1 Foods is scheduled to open around August 2016 and will employ 150 people and be open 24 hours a day. Land owner Dan Huestis was also in attendance and spoke about a 23 acre parcel of land to the east of Walmart that is in the works to be more open to more retail, and he also has 200+ acres of land to the south of Walmart for up to 450 high end homes.

Other Business:

Mitch Tropila spoke about his campaign for the Cascade County Commission seat. He spoke about his values and his track record in Helena. He also answered questions from those in attendance.
