Mac gave a report on the Police Advisory Board. The police department has been using DDACTS to gather data on crime and activity in the area. The program started the first of May and concentrates on traffic from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm and on crime from 6:00 pm to 6:00 am. Most calls result in 15 minutes work followed by 45 minutes of paperwork. The chief is asking for three more officers.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Amy Rapp, Dem., running for HD20 gave a brief talk about her campaign and asked for our support.
