Authorizing Resolution

WHEREAS, a goal of the City Commission is to encourage a broad range of economic development opportunities in our community; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission created High Plains Development Authority, Inc. to be the economic development agent in the community; and

WHEREAS, in order for High Plains to be success in their economic development efforts, it is critical that they are designated as the Certified Community lead organization.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS:

The City Commission of Great Falls endorses the High Plains Development Authority, Inc., as the Certified Community lead organization for Great Falls, Montana, which has been designated as a Montana Certified Community; and authorizes it to complete and maintain certification requirements on behalf of the community. We will voluntarily comply with the certification requirements established by the Montana Certified Communities Program in exchange for preferential information, referrals, grant funds and other incentives from the Montana Department of Commerce.

The Great Falls City Commission pledges to cooperate in achieving the requirements, which will entitle our community to be certified for three additional years.
