

## RESOLUTION NO. 9210

### A RESOLUTION TO CONSOLIDATE & MODIFY THE BOUNDARIES OF SPECIAL LIGHTING DISTRICTS NO. 900, 955 AND 1040 TO BE KNOWN HENCEFORTH AS CONSOLIDATED SPECIAL LIGHTING DISTRICT – TRILATERAL LIGHTING “SLD-T” NO. 1297.

#### WHEREAS:

- A. The City Commission of the City of Great Falls, Montana, finds it advantageous and convenient to create the boundaries of Special Lighting District – Trilateral Lighting “SLD-T” No. 1297 by consolidating for assessment and other administrative purposes within said district all of Special Lighting Districts No. 900, 955 and 1040, and;
- B. All ninety-six (96) light fixtures, poles, and wiring, existing and proposed are of similar size, type, and material, and;
- C. That the consolidated boundaries of the new Special Lighting District – Trilateral Lighting “SLD-T” No. 1297 are as shown on the attached Exhibit “A” and are hereby declared to be further defined as follows:

#### Legal Description for SLD 900:

Beginning at the intersection of the center lines of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Alley So. Extending thence Easterly, 4,730 feet, more or less, along the center line of 10<sup>th</sup> Alley South to its intersection with the center line of 14<sup>th</sup> Street, extending thence Southerly, 400 feet, more or less, along the center line of 14<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the center line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South, extending thence Westerly, 820 feet, more or less, along the center line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South to its intersection with the West line of the Hillcrest First Addition, extending thence Northerly 10 feet along the West boundary line of Hillcrest First addition to its intersection with the North line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South extending thence Westerly 3010 feet, more or less, along the North line extended of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South to its intersection with the East line of 5<sup>th</sup> Street South, extending thence Northerly 150 feet along the East line of 5<sup>th</sup> Street South to the south line of 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. South, extending thence West, 430 feet, more or less, along the South line of 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. South to the East line of 4<sup>th</sup> Street South extending thence South and West along the City Limits line to the center line extended of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street South, extending thence North along the center line extended and the center line of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street South to its intersection with the center line of 10<sup>th</sup> Alley South at the point of beginning.

#### Legal Description for SLD 955:

Beginning at a point which is the intersection of the centerline of 14<sup>th</sup> St. So. and 10<sup>th</sup> Alley S.; proceed thence Easterly along the centerline of 10<sup>th</sup> Alley South to its intersection with the centerline of 28<sup>th</sup> St. S.; thence Southerly along the centerline of 28<sup>th</sup> St. S. to its intersection with the South property line of 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.; thence Westerly along the South property line of 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. to the East property line of Block 1, Lincoln Heights Add.;

thence Southerly along the East property line of Block 1, Lincoln Heights Add. to its intersection with the centerline of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley S.; thence Westerly along the centerline of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley S. to its intersection with the West line of 24<sup>th</sup> St. S.; thence Northerly along the West line of 24<sup>th</sup> St. So. to its intersection with the South property line of 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.; thence Westerly along the South property line of 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. to its intersection with the East line of 20<sup>th</sup> St. S.; thence Southerly along the East line of 20<sup>th</sup> St. S. to its intersection with the centerline of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley S.; thence Westerly along the centerline of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley S. to its intersection with the centerline of 14<sup>th</sup> St. S.; thence Northerly along the centerline of 14<sup>th</sup> St. S. to its intersection with the centerline of 10<sup>th</sup> Alley S. the point of beginning.

Legal Description for SLD 1040:

Beginning at the intersection of the center lines of 34<sup>th</sup> Street South and 10<sup>th</sup> Alley South; proceed East along the center line of 10<sup>th</sup> Alley South to the center line of 38<sup>th</sup> Street South; thence South along the center line and center line extended of 38<sup>th</sup> Street South to the center line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South; thence West along the center line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South to the extended center line of 34<sup>th</sup> Street South; thence North along the extended center line and center line of 34<sup>th</sup> Street South to the center line of 10<sup>th</sup> Alley South and point of beginning.

**D.** That the modification area boundaries are hereby to be defined as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South and the west boundary line of 24<sup>th</sup> Street South; proceed west along the extended center line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South to its intersection with the east boundary line of 20<sup>th</sup> Street South; thence north along the east boundary line of 20<sup>th</sup> Street South to its intersection with the south boundary line of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue South; proceed east along the south boundary line of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue South to its intersection with the west boundary line of 24<sup>th</sup> Street South; thence south along the west boundary line of 24<sup>th</sup> Street South to the point of beginning.

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South and the east boundary line of 5<sup>th</sup> Street South; proceed west along the extended center line of 11<sup>th</sup> Alley South to its intersection with the west boundary line of 4<sup>th</sup> Street South; thence north along the west boundary line of 4<sup>th</sup> Street South to its intersection with the south boundary line of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue South; thence east along the south boundary line of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue South to its intersection with the east boundary line of 5<sup>th</sup> Street South; thence south along the east boundary line of 5<sup>th</sup> Street South to the point of beginning.

**E.** That the consolidation and modification of this Street Lighting District will supersede and take precedence over any existing, overlapping street lighting district's boundaries and improvements.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 2002, the City Commission of the City of Great Falls, Montana, adopted a Resolution of Intent to Consolidate and Modify No. 9210 entitled:

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT TO BE THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS, MONTANA TO CONSOLIDATE & MODIFY THE BOUNDARIES OF SPECIAL LIGHTING DISTRICTS NO. 900, 955 AND 1040 TO BE KNOWN HENCEFORTH AS CONSOLIDATED SPECIAL LIGHTING DISTRICT – TRILATERAL LIGHTING “SLD-T” NO. 1297.

Resolution of Intent to Consolidate and Modify No. 9210 is on file in the office of the City Clerk, Peggy J. Bourne, (406) 455-8541, Civic Center, 2 Park Drive, Great Falls, Montana, to which reference is hereby made for a description of the boundaries of said district.

That the City Commission of the City of Great Falls, Montana, will be in session on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2002, at 7:00 o'clock p.m., in the Commission Chambers in the Civic Center, at which time and place the City Commission will hear objections to consolidation and modification of said Lighting District. Any person or persons, who are owners of any lot or parcel of land within said Special Lighting District – Trilateral Lighting SLD-T No. 1297, who shall, within 15 days after the first publication of this notice have delivered to the City Clerk of the City of Great Falls, a protest in writing against the proposed consolidation of said lighting district, shall have the right to appear at said meeting in person or by counsel, and show cause, if any there be, why such lighting district should not be consolidated.
