**IN THE MATTER AMENDING RESOLUION 9220 AND CASCADE COUNTY  
RESOLUTION 02-78 PERTAINING TO THE NATIVE AMERICAN LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
COMMISSION**

City of Great Falls Resolution No. 9264  
Cascade County Resolution No. 02-78

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**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Cascade County, Montana, and the City Commission of the City of Great Falls, Montana, created a Native American Local Government Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose for this joint commission is to serve as a local “point-of-contact” for all local City and County government departments; to represent the Native American community at the City and County government meetings, functions and events; to advise City and County governments on Native American needs, issues, forums and planning; to assist and advise in the coordinated review of the status of the local Native American community; and to serve as a clearinghouse of information on grants, employment opportunities and economic development activities for dissemination to Native American communities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GREAT FALLS CITY COMMISSION, CASCADE COUNTY, MONTANA, AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CASCADE COUNTY, MONTANA, THAT THE NATIVE AMERICAN LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION COMPOSITION BE MODIFIED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Standing members including the highest ranking Native American officer in the Great Falls Public Education system, the Indian Heritage Association Director and the Indian Family Clinic Director.
2. Four rotating members with staggered terms (1 to 4 years), recommended by standing members (who review applications), two shall be appointed by the Great Falls City Commission and two shall be appointed by the Cascade County Commission; and
3. Chair of the Commission will be elected by the members of the Native American Local Government Commission.

The meetings of the Commission shall be determined by the members of the Native American Local Government Commission but shall meet at least monthly. Minutes shall be kept of all meetings and the meetings are subject to the principles of the Open Meeting law of the State of Montana.
