A RESOLUTION DECLARING "USE VARIANCES" UNUTILZED SINCE 1990, OR AT ALL, TO BE ABANDONED

WHEREAS, in 1980, pursuant to Ordinance 2228, the City Commission decreed that "use variances" from zoning, housing and building ordinances, "should not be permitted under any circumstances"; and,

WHEREAS, a new Land Development and Zoning Code is under review and is expected to be presented to the City Commission for adoption on or before May of 2004; and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the public interest to augment the establishment of a new Land Development and Zoning Code by declaring all "use variances" previously approved but which have not been utilized since 1990 or at all, to be abandoned and hereafter, to be of no force or effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS, CASCADE COUNTY, MONTANA:

That "use variances" previously approved but which have not been utilized since 1990 or at all, are hereby deemed to be abandoned and hereafter, to have no force or effect.
