A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH SWIMMING POOL DAILY FEES
FOR MITCHELL, WATER TOWER, JAYCEE, AND NATATORIUM SWIMMING POOLS

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Great Falls, Cascade County, Montana; That all past fee structures for swimming pools as established in Resolution 9233 are hereby amended.
