A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH ELECTRIC SUPPLY RATES AND AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE FOR ELECTRIC CITY POWER AFTER APPROVAL BY THE CITY COMMISSION

WHEREAS:

The City Commission of the City of Great Falls met and conducted the hearing in regular session on Tuesday, July 19, 2005 at the Civic Center, Great Falls, Montana, at 7:00 p.m. and did consider the cost of operating and servicing the customers of Electric City Power;

According to the Request for Electric Utility Service, signed October 2004, by each of the existing customers:

“ECP will charge the customer at an initial rate of \$37.60 per megawatt hour during the first year of service. Any revisions in the rate will be at the discretion of the Great Falls City Commission, after a required public response period. The rate is guaranteed not to exceed \$40.00 per megawatt hour during the term of this contract”

NOW, THEREFORE:

The City Commission of the City of Great Falls does hereby establish an electrical supply rate of \$40.00 per megawatt hour and an administrative fee of \$3.00 per account per month on existing accounts of Electric City Power through December 31, 2008.
