

RESOLUTION 9516

A RESOLUTION ASSESSING THE COSTS INCURRED IN THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT LOT 2, BLOCK 113, GREAT FALLS ELEVENTH ADDITION, GREAT FALLS, CASCADE COUNTY, MONTANA, ADDRESSED AS 2304 8 AVENUE NORTH, AGAINST SAID PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the owner of the property located at Lot 2, Block 113, Great Falls Eleventh Addition, Great Falls, Cascade County, Montana, 2304 8th Avenue North was issued a notice to clean the property.

WHEREAS, after due notice the property owner did not clean the property.

WHEREAS, staff used a contractor and Public Works crew to clean the property.

WHEREAS, the contractor and Public Works crew completed clean-up with Community Development staff approving the work.

WHEREAS, the City Commission set October 4, 2005, at 7:00 p.m. for this hearing, to show cause why the property owner should not be held liable for the costs incurred in clean-up of said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS, MONTANA, THAT:

The amount of \$ 688.60 for cleanup costs incurred in the abatement of a nuisance at Lot 2, Block 113, Great Falls Eleventh Addition, Great Falls, Montana, described as 2304 8th Avenue North, be assessed against the property itself, with interest and penalties on the unpaid balance.
