

RESOLUTION 9949

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CASCADE COUNTY
PRE-DISASTER MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, in October of 2000, the President of the United States signed into law the “Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000” (PL 106-390) to amend the “Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Act of 1988” which, among other provisions, requires local governments to adopt a Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan in order to be eligible for hazard mitigation funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Great Falls has worked closely with Cascade County Disaster and Emergency Services to develop a county-wide Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan that will serve the needs of Cascade County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Great Falls supports the Cascade County Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan as a logical means toward protecting people and property from the potential devastating effects of natural and man-made hazards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Great Falls that the “Cascade County, Montana Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan,” as approved by the Montana Department of Emergency Services (MDES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), is hereby adopted.
