ORDINANCE 2802

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING OCCGF 10.36 PERTAINING TO ESTABLISHING SPEED RESTRICTIONS IN ALLEYS.

WHEREAS, when Title 10 was recodified in 1993, the section limiting the speed limit in alleys to 15 mph was deleted; and

WHEREAS, staff from the City Attorney's office and the Public Works Department requested the speed limit in alleys be reestablished because it is a safe and prudent speed for the road conditions typically located in alleys; and

WHEREAS, since many pedestrians use the alleys for a variety of purposes, it a slower speed limit establishes better safety standards between motorists and pedestrians.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS, MONTANA:

Section 1. That OCCGF Title 10.36 be amended to include the following:

Sections:

10.36.010 Established--Specific streets.

10.36.020 Estblished - Alleys

<u>10.36.020 Established–Alleys</u>. The speed limit for all alleys within the City limits shall be 15 miles per hour. (Ord. 2802, 2001; Ord. 2446, 1987; prior code §10 2 5(A)).
