

RESOLUTION 10571

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2024-2029 CENTRAL MONTANA REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Great Falls, Montana, recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency pre- and post- disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Great Falls resides within the Planning Area, and fully participated in the mitigation planning process to prepare this Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Disaster & Emergency Services and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials have reviewed the 2024-2029 Central Montana Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Great Falls Montana, that the 2024-2029 Central Montana Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan, is hereby adopted as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY SAID CITY COMMISSION that Resolution 10571 be submitted to the Montana Disaster & Emergency Services and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials to enable the Plan's final approval.
