## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2024-2029 CENTRAL MONTANA REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

**WHEREAS**, the Montana Disaster & Emergency Services and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials have reviewed the 2024-2029 Central Montana Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Great Falls Montana, that the 2024-2029 Central Montana Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan, is hereby adopted as an official plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY SAID CITY COMMISSION** that Resolution 10571 be submitted to the Montana Disaster & Emergency Services and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials to enable the Plan's final approval.
