

RESOLUTION 10600

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
GREAT FALLS, MONTANA, ADOPTING THE CITY OF GREAT
FALLS STORMWATER MASTER PLAN.

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WHEREAS, the Stormwater Master Plan, hereafter referred to as “Plan”, is a planning level document to identify a range of drainage improvement projects to inform the city in addressing existing system deficiencies and serve the city as it grows; and

WHEREAS, the original Plan, dated February 1989, was adopted by the Commission and is proposed to be replaced by the 2025 Plan as allowed by City law; and

WHEREAS, the Plan promotes that the health, safety, welfare, and property of the City and citizens will be safeguarded and protected through the proper control and drainage of storm and surface water; and

WHEREAS, the Plan may be revised for future changes to accommodate city growth or compliance with applicable federal, state and local regulations; and

WHEREAS, proposed departures from the Plan will be evaluated by City Staff on the basis that the proposal will produce acceptable functional, aesthetic, safe and economic results for the user, the environment, and the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS, MONTANA, that the City of Great Falls Storm Drainage Design Manual is adopted as set forth and copies are available upon request at the Public Works Department.
