How about putting together some basic info for me including, but not limited to:

Number of merchants who participate in program 34 customers as of 8-31-11  
Number of tokens sold per yr. 6,900 sold as of 8-31-11. Revenue from sales is 345.00  
Number of tokens utilized per year (revenue) 5,970 tokens collected as of 8-31-11. Revenue is 298.50

I've not made a final decision, but an option might be that in lieu of the token program we encourage merchants to participate in the courtesy program. I have to be convinced that this program is important enough to use parking funds to subsidize it.
