MINUTES

Prior to the meeting, Committee members were provided a copy of the September 13, 2018, meeting minutes. Mr. Finch moved to approve the minutes, seconded by Mr. Raymond. All being in favor, the minutes were approved as submitted.

BUSINESS ITEMS

5.A. – Transit Performance Measures and Targets

Mr. Finch introduced the agenda item regarding consideration of the Great Falls Transit District's (GFTD) Performance Measures and Targets. He noted that included in the meeting packet was the full Transit Asset Management Plan the GFTD prepared and adopted. The MPO agreed to adopt the Performance Measures and Targets that were adopted by the State Department of Transportation. Mr. Finch turned it over to Mr. Helgeson to give the Committee a brief overview.

Mr. Helgeson said the document gives the Transit District and the public and idea of where they are with their assets, and currently they are in good shape. He reviewed the asset register, and noted all vehicles and

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equipment are within their useful life. The target is to have no more than 10% of vehicles exceeding their useful life. The targets in the document are attainable targets for the Transit District.

There was discussion on funding in the future, and having the available funds for the two buses exceeding their useful life next year.

MOTION: That the Great Falls Technical Advisory Commission approve and recommend to the Policy Coordinating Committee that the Great Falls MPO adopt and support the Transit District's Performance Measures and Targets as represented in the most recent Asset Management Plan, and also incorporate them into the MPO Planning Documents.

Mr. Finch noted the State has required the Cooperative Agreement be re-done to add performance measures and revamps the way membership is appointed.
