MINUTES

Prior to the meeting, Committee members were provided a copy of the November 8, 2018, meeting minutes. Mr. Helgeson moved to approve the minutes, seconded by Mr. Dobbs. All being in favor, the minutes were approved as submitted.

BUSINESS ITEMS

5.A. – 2019 STP-Urban Project Selection

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Mr. Finch introduced the agenda item by reviewing current STP-Urban funded projects, and said the Great Falls MPO needs to select a new project to move forward into the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The City of Great Falls submitted a recommendation for moving forward with a project to reconstruct 9th St NW between Central Ave. West and the NW Bypass. He then turned it over to the City Public Works TAC members, to expand on the 9th Street project.

Mr. Dobbs stated the approximately ten blocks proposed for reconstruction are heavily used and the stretch of roadway has numerous deficiencies that can be corrected, including pavement distress, storm drainage, and ADA compliance. Mr. Jorgensen said that he would like to see a boulevard sidewalk, as this route is an emergency snow route.

There was discussion on cost of projects and Mr. Finch said there is about 7 million dollars in the 5 year TIP and would like to continue to expend our allocations for the urban projects.

MOTION: That the Great Falls Technical Advisory Committee approve the reconstruction of 9th Street NW from Central Ave West to the Northwest Bypass to urban collector standards as the MPO's next STP-Urban funded project, and recommend PCC amend the TIP accordingly.

Mr. Finch explained the next steps in the process.

Mr. Rearden encouraged TAC members to be thinking of other projects and suggested that another project be nominated at the next TAC meeting. There was discussion about project prioritization and potential projects to bring forward. Mr. Finch agreed to send TAC members a list of recommended projects from the Long Range Transportation Plan.

Ms. Patera expressed her support and thanked the TAC for moving forward the 9th Street NW project.
