

VERIZON WIRELESS ANTENNAS IN BELL TOWER 1900 2ND AVENUE SOUTH



Project Description

The owner and applicant are proposing construction of concealed telecommunication antennas inside the existing Great Falls High School Bell Tower and utilizing the existing openings behind screening panels that would be flat black and blend in with the shadows of the bell tower. The radio equipment, cables and cabinets necessary to operate the facility will be located in a new room in the basement of the school. The accompanying emergency power generator and air conditioning condenser will be located on the ground, within a sight-obscuring fence enclosure, in a paved courtyard and hidden by the school building. Verizon Wireless proposes the new antennas in order to better serve the growing demands on existing wireless facilities in the vicinity.

Project Overview

Conformance with Title 17

The proposed concealed telecommunication facility appears to be compliant with the relevant requirements of Title 17 of the Land Development Code, including but not limited to zoning, setbacks, height, design, and visibility. The applicant has worked with Great Fall's Historic Preservation Officer, Ellen Sievert on the design by concealing the antennas within the existing bell tower.

Conformance with Title 15

The applicant shall develop plans and specifications in conformance with the relevant requirements of Title 15 Building and Construction, of the Land Development Code.

Conformance with Title 5

The applicant shall license and register the telecommunication tower in conformance with the relevant requirements of Title 5 Telecommunication Facility licensing requirements, of the Land Development Code.

Design Review: Exhibit 28-1 Standards for New Construction of Telecommunication Tower

The submitted plan for a concealed telecommunication antennas meets the intent of the standards of Exhibit 28-1 of the Land Development Code.

Recommendation

Staff supports this application and recommends the Design Review Board approve the submitted design with conditions.

If such proposed change would alter the plan, the proposal shall be resubmitted for review as a new application.
