CITY OF GREAT FALLS
Amendment to 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan

The City of Great Falls is making an amendment to its 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan available to the public through this notice. This amendment will enable the City of Great Falls to receive and administer a special allocation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. This allocation was authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) and includes \$475,515 under Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV). This amendment is available for a 5-day public review and comment period from June 19, 2020, through June 23, 2020. The amended 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan will be available for viewing at the Great Falls Public Library, the Planning and Community Development Office, Civic Center, Room 112, during regular business hours, and on the City of Great Falls website (<https://greatfallsmt.net/planning>). As part of this amendment, the City of Great Falls has revised the Consolidated Plan's Citizen Participation Plan to include the 5-day comment period as indicated above in order to expedite and facilitate the use of CDBG-CV funds.
