LaBard stated that the application(s) of Rich Hollis, Alice Klundt, Robert Long, Samara Sant, Charles Goodman, Jared Alleman, and Daniel Barnett were before the Police Commission for their review and discussion. Pursuant to the City of Great Falls Resolution No. 10524, passed and adopted August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, applications must be open to the public even if a sitting member eligible for reappointment wishes to do so as outlined in Section 3 of the resolution.
