What they accept: copper, aluminum, brass, lead, lead acid batteries, aluminum cans, tin, appliances, radiators, vehicles, iron, stainless steel, and insulated copper wire. If it is made of metal, Steel Etc. will buy it. Refrigerators and freezers with Freon removed (Freon removal cost is \$25). No glass is accepted and no plastic is being accepted at this time due to export market issues.

What they accept: plastic bags and ink cartridges. Recycling containers are located at the front of the store, near the photo department.

- Republic Services customers can bag their yard waste and put out on their regular pick up day.
- Citizens can also take their yard waste to the High Plains Landfill located at 142 Powerline Road, Floweree, MT. Effective 1/6/19 Monday-Friday from 7 am to 5:30 pm, Saturday 9 am to 7 pm, Closed – Sunday & major holidays. The tipping fee is \$32.00 per ton. A \$10 fine can be imposed if loads are not secured with a rope, strap or tarp. For more information and/or questions, call the landfill at 452-3143.
