Tickets are available in advance at Mansfield Box Office, M-F, 11:00 am to 4:30 pm, enter through door C of the Great Falls Civic Center. For the best prices, the purchase of an Anytime Pack for \$100 provides 4 admissions (buy 3 and get the 4th admission free) which may be used in any combination during the season. To purchase the Anytime Pack, call the Symphony at 406.453.4102 or go to the Symphony Patron Services table in the lobby before the concert.

On the day of the concert, the box office opens in the theater lobby at 1:30 pm for ticket sales. Special \$5 student rush tickets are available at this time for any full time student regardless of age.
